How do you become involved?

1. Submit your design on or attached to this form to the gallery with your contact information and you will be notified when it is approved.
2. Sign up for a projection and painting time. Sign up sheets will be available at the gallery after February 21st.
3. At the gallery, your design will be projected onto a 24" wide by 60" high banner that is stretched on a frame. You will trace your design on the banner with a pencil.
4. Paint your banner with acrylic paint in a range of colours.
5. Painting will be done between March 1st and April 16th, 2011 at the Summerland Art Centre during the time that you have signed up for on the painting schedule
6. Banners will be installed around town for the May long weekend.
7. Winning of successful bids will be notified by October 30th, 2012 and will be expected to pick up banners before December 21st, 2012.
